A homeless student is defined as an individual who lacks a fixed, regular & adequate night-time residence.

This includes children & youth who:

- Are “doubled-up” and sharing housing due to economic hardship (grandparent, relative, friend);
- Live in domestic abuse shelters, emergency shelters or transitional housing;
- Are teens who “couch surf” and temporarily stay at different friends homes;

If your child is homeless, using the above definition and you need assistance with school supplies, course fee waivers or free school meals, contact your child’s guidance counselor, school principal or the School District of Ashland Homeless Liaison, Amanda Popovich (715-682-7080, x 6004).
