- Weekly Summer School classes start at 8:15 until 3:20
  - Full day includes:
    - 25 minute recess between 1st & 2nd class
    - 70 minute combination recess & lunch period
  - Choose from 3 classes per week to build your student(s) summer school schedule
- All Fee's **must** be paid on or before the last day of registration-Monday, May 23rd at midnight.
- Free summer breakfast program “Grab-n-go” bag breakfast.
- Transportation for students living in Odanah -
  - Mornings:** Transportation via school bus will be available for Bad River students during SDA Summer School, to get to summer school. The school bus will pick-up Bad River students in the Bad River Transit parking lot area in Odanah at **7:30 am**, Monday-Friday. Students coming from Birch Hill, Frank's Field and Aspen Acres can use the Bad River Transit bus to get to the school bus in the morning. The bus will leave Bad River at **7:40 am**. Education Dept. staff will be at the Bad River Transit area in the morning to assist.
  - Afternoons:** Transportation via school bus will be available for Bad River students after SDA Summer School, back to the Bad River Transit parking lot area. The bus will arrive in Odanah at approximately **3:50 pm**. Students going to Birch Hill, Frank's Field and Aspen Acres, can connect with the Bad River Transit to get home. Education Dept. staff will be at the Bad River Transit area in the afternoons to assist.

## General Guidelines and Procedures

*Class sizes are limited and will be filled on a first come, first served basis.*

*Some class sizes will not be able to be increased due pre-purchased supplies*

*Some classes will not be able to allow 'last minute' enrollments due to pre-purchased supplies.*

Classes are open to all School District of Ashland students.

Unless there is a supply fee for consumable materials there is no cost for district residents.

Out-of-district resident fees are \$50 per class plus any special materials fee if applicable.

### Attendance:

Except for emergencies, students are expected to attend all summer school classes. This program is funded through a formula that is based upon student attendance. If the students is not able to attend in the event of an emergency or illness, parents should contact the school office at 715-682-7089 by 8:00 a.m.

Students are expected to attend all of their summer school classes for the entire scheduled class time, so please schedule family vacations and other events accordingly. Students who do not come to the first and second day of class are automatically taken off the enrollment. Students are automatically dropped from summer school after the third absence. If your students decide not to attend, please contact Cheryl Tody at 715-682-7089 so that we can open up the class for others to attend.

### SUMMER SCHOOL CLASS INFORMATION:

**Class Cancellations:** All classes are tentative; contingent on staffing and enrollment. Within a week of the end of the enrollment period, if a class does not meet the minimum enrollment, all students in the class will be enrolled in a class that has space available and in a similar subject. Parents will be contacted if students are enrolled into a different class. Also, at the end of the second day of summer school, if a class does not have the minimum enrollment it will be cancelled. Parents will be contacted if the class is cancelled.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION AND EXPECTATIONS:**

**Cell phones:** Students may possess cell phones while they are in summer school, but the telephones must be turned off and out of sight during class sessions unless the teacher is incorporating them into the class. They may be used at the start and end of the school day.

**Student Conduct:** Students are expected to follow the same school rules and standards of conduct which apply during the regular school year. Summer school staff will contact parents if behavior issues occur in the classroom, hallways, outside, etc. If problems continue, the student may be removed from the class and may lose the privilege of attending any summer school classes. There is no suspension, detention or in-school suspension during summer school.

The following behavior expectations supersede the regular school year policies and will result in automatic dismissal from summer school: Possession of any smoking or drug paraphernalia including cigarettes, rolling papers, lighters, etc. Swearing at a teacher or walking out of class. Any illegal activity including harassment or discrimination

**Student Dress:** Students are expected to dress appropriately for summer school, no swimwear or any other apparel which would detract from the learning environment. Students are required to wear shoes/sandals at all times. Hats are to be worn outside only.

**Supervision:** Please note that we will not have any supervision available to watch children if they are not participating in a class.

**Transportation:** The district does not provide transportation for its summer school program. Transportation of students to and from summer school is the responsibility of the parents/guardians. Students must be picked up immediately upon their final dismissal each day. Supervision is not available for students remaining after their last class.

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

- **Classes are listed in alphabetical order.**
- **Some classes are offered for various grade level groups.**
  - **The classes are customized to fit the age group.**

< **4TH OF JULY PARADE** = We are making decorations for the 4th of July parade. The teacher, Bob, has a couple of big ideas working....but we need students' creativity and energy to make it GO! Come prepared to get dirty! **Fee: \$5.00**  
**- Payable at time of registration**

< **ALL THE WORLD IS A STAGE** = and now you too can be on it. Do you feel creative? Do you like to work on a team? Then this is the place for you. Together we will create a play unique to the group. We will learn the who, what, when where and why of the characters in a story. At the end you will be able to be a character and act out a part of the play that you helped create!

< **ANIMAL LOVERS** = A class for those who love to learn and spend time with animals! We will spend our time learning about different animals, reading some great animal books, doing animal crafts, and even MEETING some cool animals! We will focus on horses, cows, goats, pigs, cats, dogs, and a few others. You will love our adorable animal guests!

< **ANYONE CAN CODE** = Code.org, Code Combat, Scratch, Tynker and Ozobots and others try them all. Students will use computational thinking, problem solving, programming concepts and digital citizenship. And engage with Computer Science as a medium for creativity, communication, problem solving, and fun.

< **AROUND THE WORLD** = Have you ever wanted to travel to different places around the world? Now here is the change without ever leaving Ashland County. We will visit places like China, Italy and Egypt. Discuss and build major landmarks and try out the food from each country. I am looking forward to travelling with you and you don't even need a suitcase.

< **ATHLETIC CONDITIONING** = Speed development, Weightlifting, and Conditioning. Helping levels of athletes increase cardio respiratory endurance, strength, stamina, flexibility, coordination, agility, balance, accuracy, power, speed. This class will be held at the high school in the weight room.

< **BABYSITTING & CHILD CARE COURSE** = This babysitting course will help students provide quality care to children of all ages. The course includes topics such as choosing age-appropriate activities, basic child care, like bottle feeding, child behavior, leadership, professionalism, safety, starting a babysitting business and more! Students will gain the skills necessary to provide safe and responsible child care for children. Best of all, with successful completion of the course, you'll earn a Red Cross certificate that you can use to demonstrate your skills and build your resume.  
**Students must be 11 years of age at the start of the class to enroll.**

< **BALLOONS, BEACH BALLS, & FITNESS** = Enjoy having fun with movement! We will play games, run relays, and use the gym for whatever we like! Our goal will be a mix of fast paced games with quiet, calm, peaceful, breath catching activities in between. Please wear any gym shoes and if you have one, bring a water bottle.

< **BASKETBALL FUNDAMENTALS & GAMES** = Working on dribbling, passing, shooting, and footwork essential to becoming a good middle school basketball player. This will be a high energy class that will truly take you to the next level. This class will also include a daily basketball oriented workout focusing on speed, quickness, body control, strength, and explosiveness. This class will be held at the high school field house. Supplies: Wear basketball shoes and exercise clothing.

< **BE A BOOK COOK! THE ART OF BAKING & COOKING!** = ½ cup of fun, 1 cup of imagination and a tablespoon of surprises....That is what you will encounter at Be a Book Cook . Come prepared each day to use your imagination as we bake and cook up treats for you, your family and friends to eat! Be amazed as you make cookies,

cakes, pizza, breakfast items, ice cream and more! Each treat we make will be connected to a children's literature book. At the end of summer school you will have your own Be a Book Cook cookbook to take home! If you like to bake, cook, have fun and use your imagination this class is for you. **Supplies: Bring an Art shirt/old t shirt that they do not mind getting messy.**

< **BLASTING OFF - EXPLORING OUTER SPACE** = In this class we will learn about the planets in our solar system, along with the sun, moon, and other outer space topics (space travel, asteroids, comets, etc). Bring your excitement for learning and be ready for a fun time!!

< **BRACELETS, BRACELETS, BRACELETS** = Welcome to the wide world of bracelets. From string to embroidery floss, glass beads to handmade paper beads, your wrists will never look better. Give them as gifts or keep them for yourself! **Fee: \$10.00 - Payable at time of Registration**

< **BUILD IT! MAKE IT! CODE IT! PLAY IT!** = Have fun building, making, coding and playing with a variety of things! Build and make creations with Legos, Geo Play, Keva Planks and more. Code with Dash and Dot robots, Ozobots, Spheros and Cubelets. Make imaginative creations out of a collection of art supplies. Play creative thinking games!

< **CARDBOARD CREATIONS** = Let your imagination go wild in this fun-filled Cardboard Creations Class! You will be putting your math and engineering skills to the test through drawing up design plans and collaborating with friends. < **CHEF IN TRAINING** = This nutrition and cooking class encourages kids to eat healthy meals and snacks and the importance of staying active through hands on learning activities. Children will learn basic cooking skills, good nutrition, healthy food choices, food safety, and the importance of physical activity.

< **CIRCLE GAMES** = Join us for your favorite meeting activities and learn some new ones too! We will do some circle drawing and add some other shapes as well! A calm, fun, creative classroom atmosphere with lots of possibilities.

< **CLASSIC RECESS GAMES** = Do you ever get bored at recess and wish you knew some fun games to play? This is the class for you! Learn classic games like 4 square, SPUD, Steal the Bacon, Pickle and some new ones too. Rainy day? No worries we'll play your favorite morning meeting activities and other fun indoor games.

< **COME TRAVEL WITH ME** = Come travel the world with me! We'll explore and learn about a variety of places around the world. We will try different foods and create a project for each place.

< **COMIC CLUB** = Develop drawing skills and characters in this fun class! Pencils, pens, colored pencils & markers, OH MY!

< **COOL, YUMMY SUMMER TREATS** = Come one, come all and let's make some yummy treats!! This is a course for beginner and intermediate chefs. You will make delicious, mouthwatering recipes. < **CRAZY COOL COLOR CRAFTS** = In this class, we will make projects with all the colors of the rainbow. We will eat colorful snacks. We will play color games and read colorful stories. We will do new and different crafts than last year's class. Come and join our crazy cool color craft FUN! **Fee: \$10.00 - Payable at time of registration**

< **ELA BOOST!** (ELA Review for Middle School Students) = This class will provide your child with an opportunity to develop their reading analysis and comprehension skills in a fun and engaging way. Each student will be supported to their level of readiness to nurture their success. This is a great opportunity to strengthen key skills for reading and cultivate a love for literacy!



< **EVERYDAY IS A HOLIDAY** = Christmas and New Years in June? Sure why not. Celebrate a different holiday every day full of crafts, snacks, and playing games. You will celebrate Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Valentine's Day, Cinco de Mayo, St. Patrick's Day, and enjoy a Fourth of July celebration! At the end of the class you will be taking home a calendar that you have created to remember each holiday.

< **EXPLORE INTERNATIONAL LIFE WITH COOKIES** = Students will have the chance to learn a little bit about five countries and a popular cookie that originated from that country through baking, hearing music and video clips. A different country and continent will be focused on each day so that the following continents are covered during the week: South America, Africa, Europe, Asia, and North America. **Fee: \$5.00 - Payable at time of registration**

< **FAIRY TALE FUN** = Children will have fun learning with some of their favorite fairy tale characters like Goldilocks, The Little Red Hen and The Three Little Pigs. Students will enjoy reading different versions of each story, creating crafts, cooking and completing STEM projects based on each story.

< **FAIRY TALE STEM** = It's the eve before the Royal wedding of Cinderella and Prince Charming, and the grumpy wizard Rumpelstiltskin is determined to ruin the special day! He has placed Cinderella under a spell that can only be broken if we solve the clues and guess the magic word! Children will travel around Once Upon A Time Land collecting letter clues by completing fairy tale challenges! When we have collected all of the clues, unscramble the letters to reveal the clue to break the spell.

< **FAIRY TALE THEATER** = Get your acting on with this fairy tale play. Study character development and stage movement to tell an amazing story!

< **FOREST FUN** = Join us for exploring the outdoors with walking tours of the elementary school forest, outdoor field games, scavenger hunts, plant identification games, berry-finding, team building activities, map reading and nature-based art.

< **FUN SUMMER SKETCHING** = What kind of fun will kids have this summer? Draw yourself doing a favorite warm-weather activity. Then write a story using illustrations only on "What I Did on Summer Vacation".

< **GAMES, GAMES, GAMES** = Hopscotch, Twister, Jump rope, Dominoes, Checkers, Jenga, and Card games just to name a few. Children can have fun while they interact, negotiate rules, take turns, correct and challenge each other; thinking and problem solving all the time. We will be outside and in.

< **GAMES & SOCIAL SKILLS** = Do you like to play games? Do you like to play outside? Then come join me this summer for a morning of games and fun. We will play old favorites and learn new games while becoming better teammates and making new friends.

< **GAME TIME 1** = Participants will learn to strategize and compete while enjoying a variety of popular games. Scrabble, Life, Checkers, Chess, Monopoly, Connect Four, dominoes, and common card games are but a few of the activities that students will enjoy. Academic games and moderate athletic activities will also be interspersed with board games. Participants will enjoy the good-natured competition and weekly tournaments to see who leaves with bragging rights for the weekend!

< **GAMETIME 2** = Come join the fun of games. We will play a variety of classic board and card games - Connect 4, Checkers, Clue, Sorry, Battleship, Uno, Farkle, etc. We will create an obstacle course too!!! Have some good competitive fun with us!

< **GET DOWN & CRAZY ART** = Come and get messy while making fun art projects. Please make sure that you are wearing artist style clothing as some items may not wash out of your clothing. This class is so crazy that some of our projects will take place outside! **Supplies: Donations are welcome. Fee: \$10.00 - Payable at time of registration**

< **GOING BUGGY** = Butterflies, ladybugs, dragonflies and bumblebees. We will explore the wonderful world of insects through stories, crafts and snacks.

< **GOLF** = Second & Third grade students will be transported to the Chequamegon Bay Golf course and have golf instruction, games and activities available with the CBAY staff.

< **GOLF I** = Fourth & Fifth grade students will be transported to the Chequamegon Bay Golf course and have golf instruction, games and activities available with the CBAY staff.

< **GOLF II** = Fourth & Fifth grade students (for those that have taken the Golf I class) will be transported to the Chequamegon Bay Golf course and have golf instruction, games and activities available with the CBAY staff.

< **HAPPY CAMPERS** = Who doesn't love camping and the great outdoors? We will be taking nature walks, doing camping and nature crafts, even making some camping treats. It will be campstastic!

< **HOMEMADE BAND INSTRUMENTS** = Students will build their own instruments from found items and then we try playing them individually and in groups. **Fee: \$5.00 - Payable at time of registration**

< **IT'S A ZOO HERE** = Love animals? This class is all about those furry creatures. We will be learning about all different types of animals, making animal crafts, listening to animal stories, making some animal inspired snacks and even doing some science related to animals.

< **KICKBALL** = Let's play kickball! We will use the gym to play the game, learn basic skills, talk about sportsmanship, stay fit and healthy, and, mostly play kickball!

< **LOVE OF LEGOS** = Ratchet up your imagination. All kinds of fun with Legos! Daily Lego creation challenges, Lego craft projects, and of course free time to create your own unique designs.

< **MATH IS FUN** (Math Review for Elementary Students) = This class will provide your child with an opportunity to develop his/her math skills in a fun and engaging way. Each student will be supported to his/her level of readiness to nurture their success. This is a great opportunity to strengthen numeracy and problem-solving skills!

< **MATH REVIEW** (Math for Middle School Students) = This class will provide your child with an opportunity to engage in mathematics in a fun and engaging way. Each student will be supported at their level of readiness to encourage their success. This is a great opportunity to strengthen key skills for number sense, problem solving and mathematical reasoning.

< **MOVIES AND MUNCHIES** = Students will watch a movie and enjoy a daily snack they created related to each movie. They will also make a craft related to each movie. Students are encouraged to bring a pillow to lounge while watching an age appropriate movie! **Fee: \$5.00 - Payable at time of registration**

< **MOVIN N GROOVIN** = Students will be engaged in fun daily activities! Students will learn about good health habits and exercise. There will be a daily activity and will include minute to win it games, mindfulness, sports, games, and yoga.

< **ONCE UPON A WHAT?** = A tale as old as time or is it? We will take a classic tale and rewrite it to fit the modern times of the 21st century. This will be a fun way to practice writing and using your own creativity to do it.

< **OOEY GOOEY FUN** = Come see just how ooey goeey this world can get! Students will explore slime and goo from all angles by making every type of slime and goo imaginable! Be ready for some messy fun! Please send your kiddos with an oversized t-shirt to protect their clothes! **Fee: \$10.00 - Payable at time of registration**

**< OUTDOOR ED & SAFETY—DNR (3 class times available. Each 1st period, 2nd period & 3rd period class is 4 weeks in length)** = This class will allow students (minimum of 11 yrs old) to gain a firsthand knowledge about working in the outdoors as a career as well as outdoor safety. Students will be introduced to using the outdoors as a topic for writing and will also be taught wildlife identification, habits, and habitat needs. Activities will include map reading, using a compass correctly, tree stand safety, archery safety, and firearm safety. Each student who participates will have the opportunity to complete their Wisconsin Hunter Education requirements. **This class is 4 weeks long. Supplies: Notebook & Pencils Fee: \$10.00 – Payable to instructor on first day of class to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (only if student wants Hunter Safety Certification) \*\* Students who want Hunter Safety Certification must register with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources prior to the start of class to obtain a DNR Customer ID Number. **< PAINTING** = Work on your painting techniques with Bob. Students will explore direct handling of materials onto surfaces. Prepare to think and make!

**< PAPER AIRPLANES** = We'll make a ton of different types of airplanes, 2 different planes per day. We will have daily contests to see who can maneuver their planes the best! We will play airplane golf and have airplane relay races too!

**< PARTY IN THE USA** = Let's celebrate American's birthday while we learn about the history of the good 'ol USA! In this Party of the USA class we will read stories, sing and create crafts while learning historic facts about our country. Party on!!

**< PLAN A DREAM VACATION** = Students may not be able to travel at the moment because of the ongoing pandemic, but if you could go anywhere in the world, which destination would you choose? Imagine that you have \$5,000 to spend on a dream vacation. Using the internet, guide books, travel brochures and maps, plan a week-long itinerary.

**< READY SET INVENT** = New products are often inspired by problems in need of solutions. This summer project challenges you to come up with an invention that solves a summer-related problem. The invention can be new or improve on an existing product. Start by brainstorming some summer annoyances. IE: a better bug repellent, a fun new game, etc. Create a prototype and a short description of how it works and materials needed to build it.

**< READING IS FUN** (Reading Review for Elementary Students) = This class will provide your child with an opportunity to develop his/her reading skills in a fun and engaging way. Each student will be supported to his/her level of readiness to nurture their success. This is a great opportunity to strengthen key skills for reading and cultivate a love for literacy!

**< SCIENCE IS FUN** = We will explore the world of science through simple experiments and stories.
