**SUPPLY LIST NOTE(S):**

**\*All of the above items will be kept in the classroom and some items will be shared.\***

**Folders** – Please choose heavy duty folders with two bottom pockets. No *Trapper Keepers* or binders.

**Backpacks** – We prefer not to have backpacks with wheels on them. Primary age students have a more difficult time maneuvering this style than traditional backpacks. We recognize that there is a concern about the weight of backpacks; however, primary age students rarely carry textbooks home.

**Gym shoes** – Being able to tie shoe laces independently is an expectation all children should be able to meet prior to entering kindergarten. If your child cannot tie his or her shoe laces independently, please provide non tying shoes (*Velcro*, for example). Please make sure that your child's shoe laces are flat, not nylon coated, and the appropriate length. Too long or too short makes it very difficult for your child to tie shoes independently.
